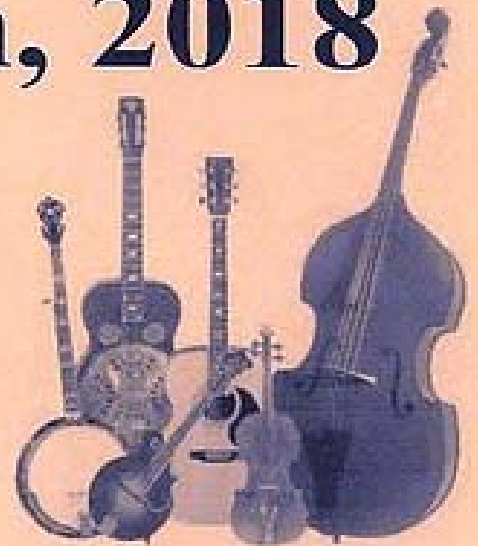

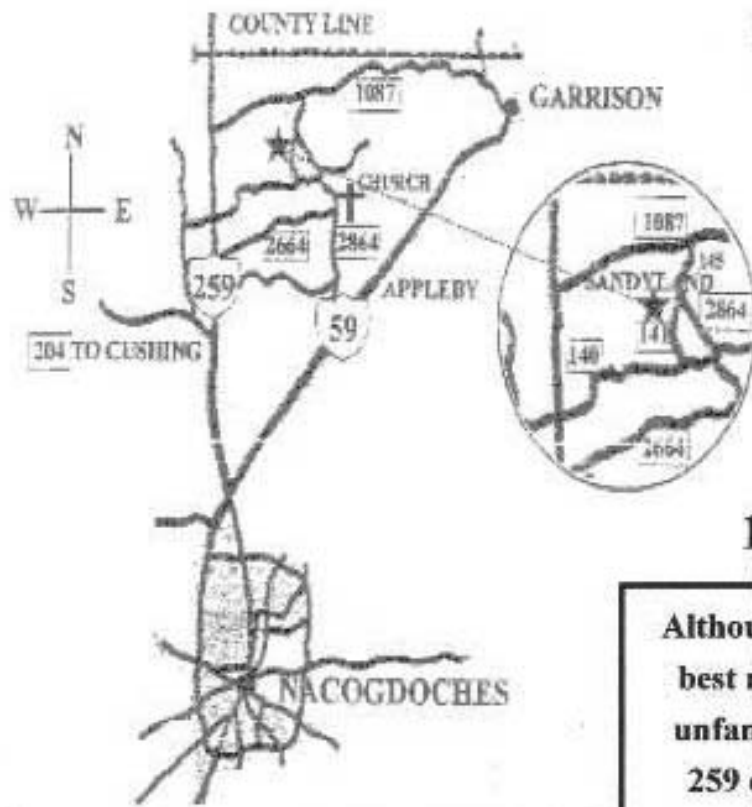

When using US Hwy 259, turn on FM 2664, which dead ends into Pleasant Hill Missionary Baptist Church. Turn **LEFT** onto FM 2864 at the Church. Continue **NORTH** to County Road 141 on your **LEFT**. FM 2864 can also be taken off of US Hwy 59. (WATCH FOR SIGNS. THE CHURCH HAS SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF 259/2664 AND 59/2864)
