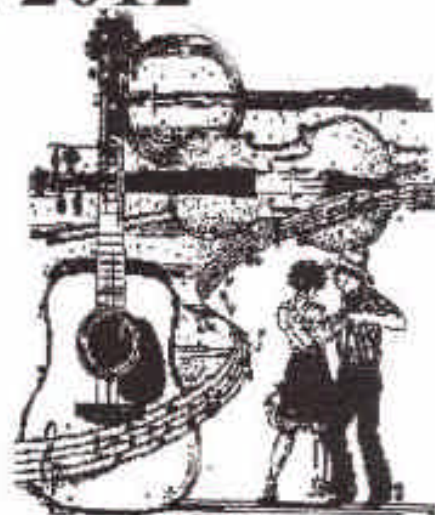

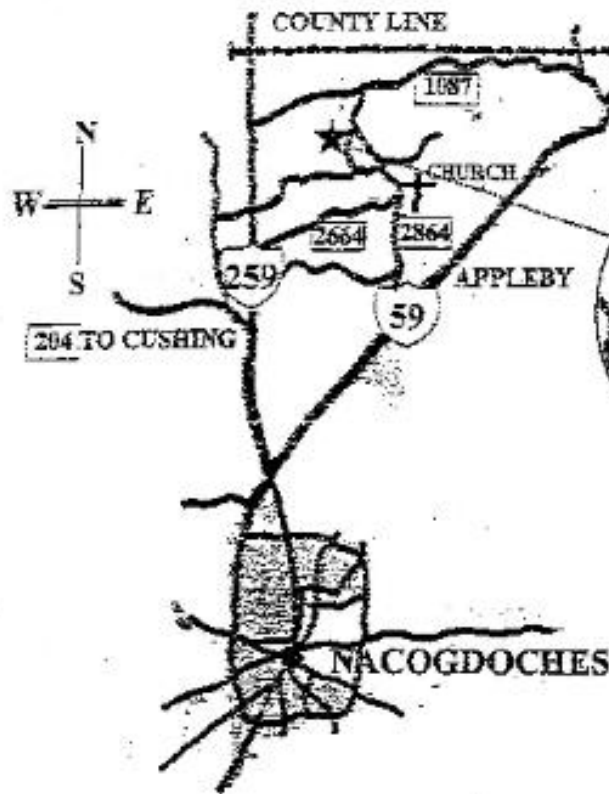

12 Miles North of Nacogdoches

Although some of the roads on the map may seem the best route, many roads are rough and/or unsafe for unfamiliar travelers. May we suggest using Hwy 259 or 59. When using 259, turn on 2664, which dead ends into Pleasant Hill Missionary Baptist Church. Turn LEFT on to 2864 at the Church. Continue NORTH to 141 on your LEFT. 2864 can also be taken off of 59. (WATCH FOR SIGNS. THE CHURCH HAS SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF 259/2664 AND 59/2864)
